

The **REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING** of the Board of Education West Hempstead Union Free School District was called to order in the Chestnut Street Board Room on August 17, 2010 at 7:57 p.m.

PRESENT: Five members of the Board: Ms. Di Miceli, Mr. Ejnes, Ms. Lotito, Mr. Mariano and Mr. Schindler. Mr. Brita and Ms. Rilling were absent. Also present were Ms. Peluso, Mr. Cunningham, Mr. Gregory Guercio, Mr. John Sheahan, Ms. Castonguay and Ms. Girolamo.

Before the meeting started, President Lotito commented on the health of Mr. Hogan and is happy to report he is doing well AND the last week being very emotional and traumatic for the community and praised everyone involved that they went “above and beyond.” Key employees were on vacation the day of the fire, yet got their prospective jobs done, as well as Administrators who acted quickly. The Board had a “walk-thru” of the fire damage and praised the Fire Department and Alejandro Crawford, Head Custodian of George Washington School. It was a huge team effort. Mr. Mariano thanked Ms. Lotito for her constant updates to the Board.

At this point of the meeting, Mr. Cunningham presented Edward Cicalese a long-awaited High School Diploma. Mr. Cicalese served in the Korean War, was a construction worker and has been married for 51 years with four children and 12 grandchildren. Due to the war he was not able to complete high school. He stressed how important it is to achieve a diploma. Long applause ensued.

Under **ROUTINE MATTERS** action was taken as follows:

Docket #0-18: Upon the motion of Mr. Mariano, seconded by Mr. Ejnes, and carried by five, the Board approved the appointment of Mr. Richard Cunningham as Acting Superintendent until which time Mr. John Hogan returns from medical leave.

Docket #0-19: The **MINUTES** of the Annual Reorganization/Regular Business Meeting held on July 6, 2010, having been received by each member several days prior to the date of this meeting, were presented, and upon motion of Mr. Ejnes, seconded by Ms. Di Miceli, and carried by five, that the reading of the Minutes of said meeting be dispensed with and that they be adopted as received.

Docket #0-20: The **TREASURER'S REPORT** for June 2010 having been received by each member several days prior to the date of this meeting, was presented, and upon motion of Mr. Ejnes, seconded by Ms. Lotito, and carried by five, the Schedule of Claims & Warrants Nos. 1 – 64, appropriation status report and revenue status report were placed on the table for discussion and then filed.

Under **REPORT OF COMMITTEES** – No Committee reports were given.

Under **SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT** – Mr. Cunningham gave the Superintendent's Report that included the update on Mr. Hogan's health commenting that he is getting better every day, he is surrounded by family and friends and he thanks us all for our thoughts and prayers. He then reported on the recent George Washington School fire in which he thanked Mrs. Ganley, Jeffrey Banfield, Chris Crawford, employees and residents for their quick actions in such a stressful time. Renu Restoration is the company doing an excellent clean up and Enviro Science Engineering is overseeing the work. The Board and Administration are very pleased at their professionalism. The first phase of cleanup is just about complete. Phase Two, replacing ceiling

tiles, repainting and restoring systems, is already underway. Hopefully clean up will be completed by August 24th. School will open as normal.

Mr. Cunningham also reported on the Federal Education Jobs Fund. The New York State share of \$10 Billion from the fund is \$607 million. The legislature now needs to determine how to distribute across the state and he will keep us informed.

Lastly he covered the schools getting prepared for the new school year that begins on September 7th; the last week of summer school; supplies are being delivered and sorted; the installation of 33 interactive projectors with more installations coming; mobilizing five net book carts and the new website will be online during September.

Ms. Lotito then opened the meeting for residents to address the Board.
