At this point of the meeting, Ms. Lotito introduced Ms. Mascia to give a library budget presentation.

**BUDGET HEARINGS**: Ms. Regina Mascia, Director of the West Hempstead Public Library, along with Mr. Ray Duran, President of the Library Board, presented their budget for the 2010-11 school year. Ms. Mascia told the audience that their dollar increase to the budget is a 0.29% increase to homeowners.

Mr. Cunningham gave a Power Point presentation reviewing the school budget, which covered the Governor's Proposal and its potential impact on West Hempstead; awaiting the adoption the New York State budget; increases in payments to the NYS Retirement Systems and NYS Health Insurance Plans mirroring declining revenue; three-part budget; staffing levels reduced; all facets of operation evaluated for improved efficiency; inter-municipal and cooperative bidding and expanding opportunities for cost sharing; programs and services crucial for students' development; proposed budget vs. contingent budget and then reminded residents to vote on May 18<sup>th</sup>.
