Under **REPORT OF COMMITTEES** – Mr. Kaye gave a brief Legislative report. He explained that the Governor is looking for \$1.2 billion in cuts. Our majority leader has promised that no money will be taken from education, at least for this year.

Ms. Rilling stated that she would be meeting with the Anna Gallagher Scholarship Committee, comprised of Mr. Mariano and Mr. Whelpley, to discuss the scholarship, including criteria, amount to be distributed, etc.

Under **SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT** – Mr. Hogan reported that Freshman

Orientation took place on Monday, August 18th and approximately 100 incoming students from

West Hempstead and Island Park attended. Dr. Price and Dr. Bovino also attended, as well as

various volunteer groups (PTSA, Government students, etc.). The students viewed a

presentation on "Making the Most Out of High School." Mr. Hogan then gave a summer update

on the buildings: George Washington School – asbestos tiles removed from three classrooms and rooms painted. Rug was removed from the Music Room and the sub-floor replaced and tiled. New doors are on order. Cornwell Avenue School – Asbestos tiles removed from the Music Room and the room has been painted. Door from the gym to the playground is on order. Middle School – The library has been carpeted and the old PA wiring and box have been removed. The parking lot is three quarters done in terms of patching, resealing and relining. High School – The library has been carpeted. A new weight machine has been installed in the Weight Room and the gym floor has been sanded and relined. The storage area in the cafeteria has been removed and the cafeteria has been painted. We are waiting on the contractor to begin upgrade work on the PA system. The new stage lighting is awaiting the return of Mr. Albinder for his input. Chestnut Street – Adelphi has vacated the building. The vacant room will be used for ESL and Speech therapy. New playground equipment will be installed shortly. Mr. Hogan also gave an update on technology: A new offsite service for disaster recovery has been added and 50 new computers have been installed in the labs at Cornwell and George Washington. Two interactive white boards have also been installed in these buildings. The 50 old computers are in the process of being installed throughout the district. Mr. Fleck is working on expanding the internet bandwidth from 1.5 megabits to 50 megabits. The Middle School library patron computers have been installed to a new location. Two new security cameras at the High School and Middle School have been installed.

Ms. Lotito then opened the meeting for residents to address the Board.
