

The **REGULAR MONTHLY BUSINESS MEETING** of the Board of Education West Hempstead Union Free School District was called to order in the High School Video Conference Room on June 16, 2009 at 7:50 p.m.

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Before the meeting began Ms. Lotito, the Board and WHEA presented Certificates of Achievement to Nathaniel Vaduthala, 4<sup>th</sup> grader, and Allen Njoku, 12<sup>th</sup> grader, finalists in the Long Island Presidents' Council of NYSUT's Annual Essay Contest. **Docket #8-335:** The **TREASURER'S REPORT** for April 2009 having been received by each member several days prior to the date of this meeting, was presented, and upon motion of Ms. Rilling, seconded by Mr. Mariano, and carried by seven, the Schedule of Claims & Warrants Nos. 11 – 56, appropriation status report and revenue status report were placed on the table for discussion and then filed.

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Under **REPORT OF COMMITTEES** – Mr. Kaye gave a legislative report that covered the Assembly passing measures to the Senate, which is presently paralyzed due to petty bickering, including losing the keys to the locker that contained bills that need to be passed; issues need to be wrapped up by the summer and two Oppenheimer bills for mandate relief and educational paperwork relief. He encouraged residents to speak up to their assemblymen and senators for relief.

Ms. Rilling covered the 40<sup>th</sup> Annual Scholarship Fund, handing out six scholarships to seniors; thanked everyone for their support and \$239,000 has been awarded to students over the years. Ms. Lotito said the children were exceptional and noted that they thanked their teachers. It was a lovely evening and the students were very deserving.

Ms. Risa Monroe (PTSA) reported on the Budget Vote Plant Sale being a huge success; the installation of new officers; senior breakfast and yearbook signing and the Middle School 8<sup>th</sup> grade dance and Middle School commencement. Ms. Theresa Walz (PTA) shared comments on

Family Fun at the Polls; the Installation Dinner and Chestnut's "Fun in the Sun" day on June 19<sup>th</sup>. Ms. Josephine Scheel (SEPTA) remarked on scholarships they gave out; this year's program meetings being very touching; encouraged signing up with e-mail addresses to have information reach the community and a new Board member, Mary Barnett.

Ms. Lotito publicly thanked the PTA, PTSA and SEPTA members for all their help this year and that they are invaluable to the District.

Under **SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT** – Mr. Hogan thanked everyone for their help this year in improving education for the students. He then introduced Ms. Peluso, who presented a Power Point presentation to the Board on the School Report Card 2007 – 2008.

Ms. Peluso covered the following: this year's cohort report; accountability; similar school data; reported on English Language Arts, Mathematics and Science for each school; cohort graduation rate; percentage of graduates earning Regents Diplomas; percentage passing Regents examinations; the Strategic Plan – setting goals and making progress; community involvement subgroup and their progress update; curriculum and data subgroup progress update; educational technology action plan progress update; Professional Development action plan and progress update; longitudinal ELA cohort and math data and future plans. Ms. Lotito requested a work session regarding cohorts and regional gaps for better understanding for the Board and residents.

Ms. Lotito then opened the meeting for residents to address the Board.
