The **REGULAR MONTHLY BUSINESS MEETING** of the Board of Education West Hempstead Union Free School District was called to order in the Chestnut Street Board Room on August 21, 2007 at 8:05 p.m.

PRESENT: Mr. Trocchia, who presided, and six other members of the Board: Mr. Brita, Ms. Lotito, Ms. Rilling, Mr. Kaye and Mr. Mariano and Mr. Whelpley. Also present were Mr. Hogan, Ms. Peluso, Ms. Aloe, Ms. Gutman, Ms. Girolamo, and members of the staff and community.

Under **ROUTINE MATTERS** action was taken as follows:

Docket #7-46: The **MINUTES** of the Regular Business Meeting held on July 17, 2007, having been received by each member several days prior to the date of this meeting, were presented, and upon motion of Mr. Mariano, seconded by Mr. Whelpley, and carried by seven, that the reading of the Minutes of said meeting be dispensed with and that they be adopted as received.

Docket #7-47: The **TREASURER'S REPORT** for June 2007 having been received by each member several days prior to the date of this meeting, were presented, and upon motion of Mr. Whelpley, seconded by Mr. Kaye, and carried by seven, the Schedule of Claims & Warrants Nos. 1-11, appropriation status report and revenue status report were placed on the table for discussion, Mr. Brita inquired on a discrepancy, and then filed.

Under **REPORT OF COMMITTEES** – Mr. Kaye gave a brief legislative report covering the re-authorization of NCLB; math and English being given precedence over other subjects; WICKS, adjustments in fund balance; two bills being signed into law this week –

signage to reflect locations of defibrillators and special education burdens back to school districts; and possible budget woes in the latter of the next four years.

Ms. Lotito reported on the New York State Commission on Local Government Efficiency and Competitiveness meeting on July 24th, also attended by Mr. Cunningham, which was established by Governor Spitzer as part of an effort to streamline government at every level. Mr. Brita is also a panel member. The meeting, with several guest speakers, covered possible partnerships between state and local governments. A commission was formed to make recommendations to improve the effectiveness and efficiency of local government by pooling resources to keep costs down. Issues discussed were property taxes; waste, fraud and abuse; unfunded mandates; Medicaid; state aid to school districts; school bus operations; health insurance plans; BOCES utilization; sanitation, water and solid waste disposal; centralizing libraries and parks and road maintenance. The state has hired two firms at \$750,000 to study consolidation in the state.

Josephine DeMarco, Co-President of the PTA, reported they had their first executive meeting last Thursday; ID tags were made for PTA members and stickers were made for visitors of the schools; and school safety and security were discussed.

Under **SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT** – Mr. Hogan covered staffing for September is almost complete; August 28th and 29th are teacher orientation days; 9th grade orientation took place on August 20th; and reported on the status of the school buildings' conditions, what has been upgraded and what is left to be done. Mr. Hogan recently attended a new superintendents' seminar, one on the No Child Left Behind Act and a SCOPE meeting that covered standards in guiding failure or success in students. This weekend he will attend a superintendent seminar in Albany with State Education representatives. Transportation routing is done, teachers are due back on September 4th and school opens on September 5th.

Mr. Trocchia then opened the meeting for residents to address the Board.
