

The **SPECIAL BUSINESS MEETING** of the Board of Education West Hempstead Union Free School District, for the purpose of discussing the reopening of schools, was called to order in the Chestnut Street Board Room on August 14, 2020 at 3:03 p.m.

PRESENT: Ms. Brohm, who presided, and three other members of the Board: Ms. Greaves (remotely), Mr. Magaraci, and Ms. Shinsato. Mr. Hoffman, Mr. Katrakazis and Mr. Trocchia were absent. Also present were Mr. Rehman, Ms. Reilly (remotely), Mr. Press, Mr. Mestecky, Mr. Dworsak and Ms. Bryant. Members of the community were present remotely.


Ms. Brohm turned the meeting over to Superintendent Daniel Rehman. Mr. Rehman gave a presentation with the intention of answering many of the questions previously provided to the district.

Mr. Rehman explained how the hybrid plan would work and stressed that this was the District's preferred method of educating the students during the pandemic. However, parents will be given the option of distance learning.

Mr. Rehman urged the community to get the facts by reading the Reopening Plan on the website, continuing to monitor the website for updates, and to reach out to building principals.

After the presentation, Mr. Rehman turned the meeting over to Ms. Brohm who urged the community to send their questions and concerns to: whreopening@whufsd.com. She announced that the next Reopening meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, August 18, 2020 after the regularly scheduled Board meeting, which will start at 7:00 p.m.

At 4:34 p.m., upon the motion of Mr. Mr. Magaraci, seconded by Ms. Shinsato and carried by four, the Board adjourned the meeting.
