The Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test will be given to all interested Juniors on Saturday, October 18, 2008 at 8:00 AM. The test will end at about 11:30 AM. Please bring two sharpened No. 2 pencils and a calculator to this exam.

Students are to arrive at the high school between 7:45 - 8:00 AM. Testing begins promptly at 8:00 AM. There will be an Island Park all points pick-up at 7:00 AM.

This test is a shortened version of the S.A.T. and part of the College Board Exam program. It should be taken by all college bound Juniors for the following reasons:

1. It is a practice test for the S.A.T. that Juniors will take in the Spring.
2. It is a Scholarship Exam of special interest to Juniors of high scholastic ability who may qualify under the National Merit Scholarship Program.

Interested sophomores may also register for the PSAT for additional exposure to this preliminary college entrance exam.

Registration will take place in the guidance office, Thursday, October 2nd, Friday, October 3rd and Monday, October 6th, during the first 20 minutes of each lunch period. Each student must bring a **CHECK** or **MONEY ORDER FOR \$20.00** made out to: **WEST HEMPSTEAD SCHOOL DISTRICT**. Be sure that your name is on the face of the check. **Late registration fee is \$25.00**
